Rules:

1. Any regular children's electric powered ride in vehicle. No four wheeler or motorcycle type vehicles allowed. Child's legs must be in a compartment. Ride in not ride on!
2. Kids 3-10 years of age may participate. There are two age groups: 3-5 and 6-10.
3. A balloon will be attached to the front and back of each vehicle. The last vehicle with a balloon un-popped will be the winner of that heat. Depending on participation we may need to have multiple heats with a championship round.
4. All children must wear approved safety helmets. Bicycle helmet will pass.
5. All doors and tailgates must be strapped shut. No sharp edges. Use zip ties or duct tape or other flexible product for making them stay shut.
6. Tires may be covered in duct tape to prevent them from breaking.
7. Must use stock factory 6 or 12 volt battery and motor only. Battery must be mounted secure and covered.
8. Vehicles may be decorated to look like a demo derby car, but can NOT re-enforce. Decoration can only be made out of the following: Card board- tape- paper- etc. Keep in mind this is for fun for the children!
9. All children must be accompanied by parent/legal guardian. Parents must stay in demo derby area until after child is done racing. Parent/legal guardian must sign waiver when checking in on race day.
10. If child gets out of the vehicle during event, that child is immediately disqualified and removed from derby area.

The safety of the children, parents, spectators, volunteers, and staff is first priority. Event organizers reserve the right to disqualify drivers and vehicles as needed.
